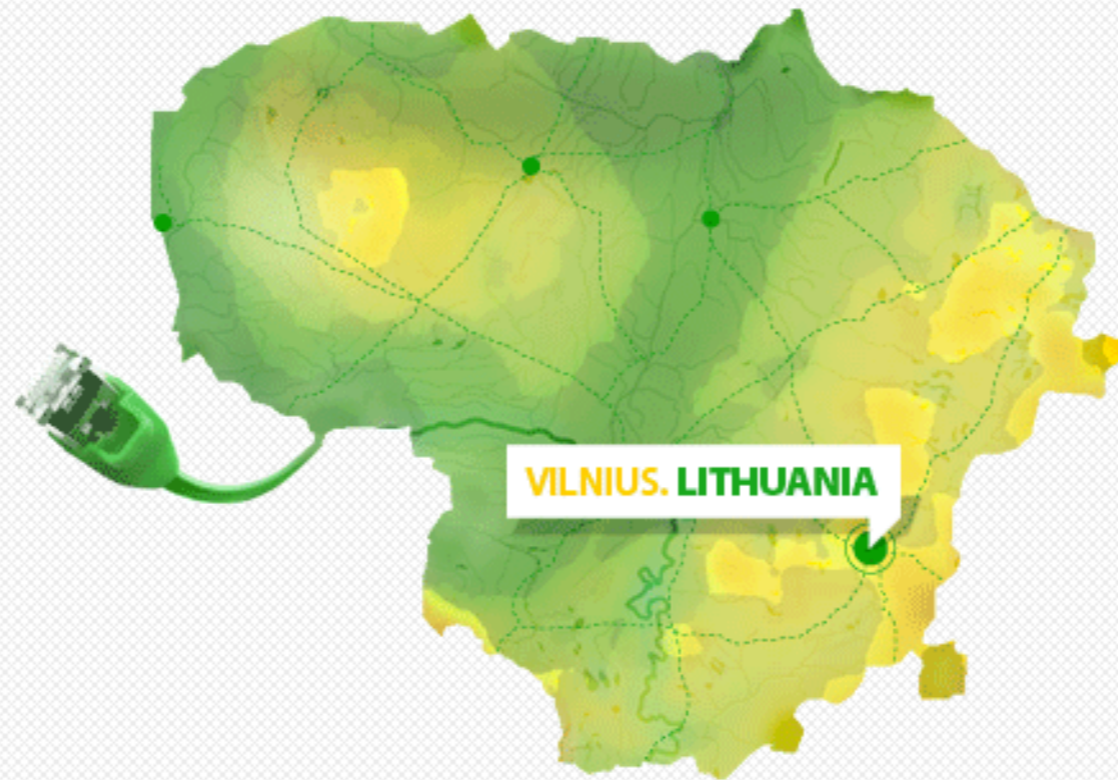

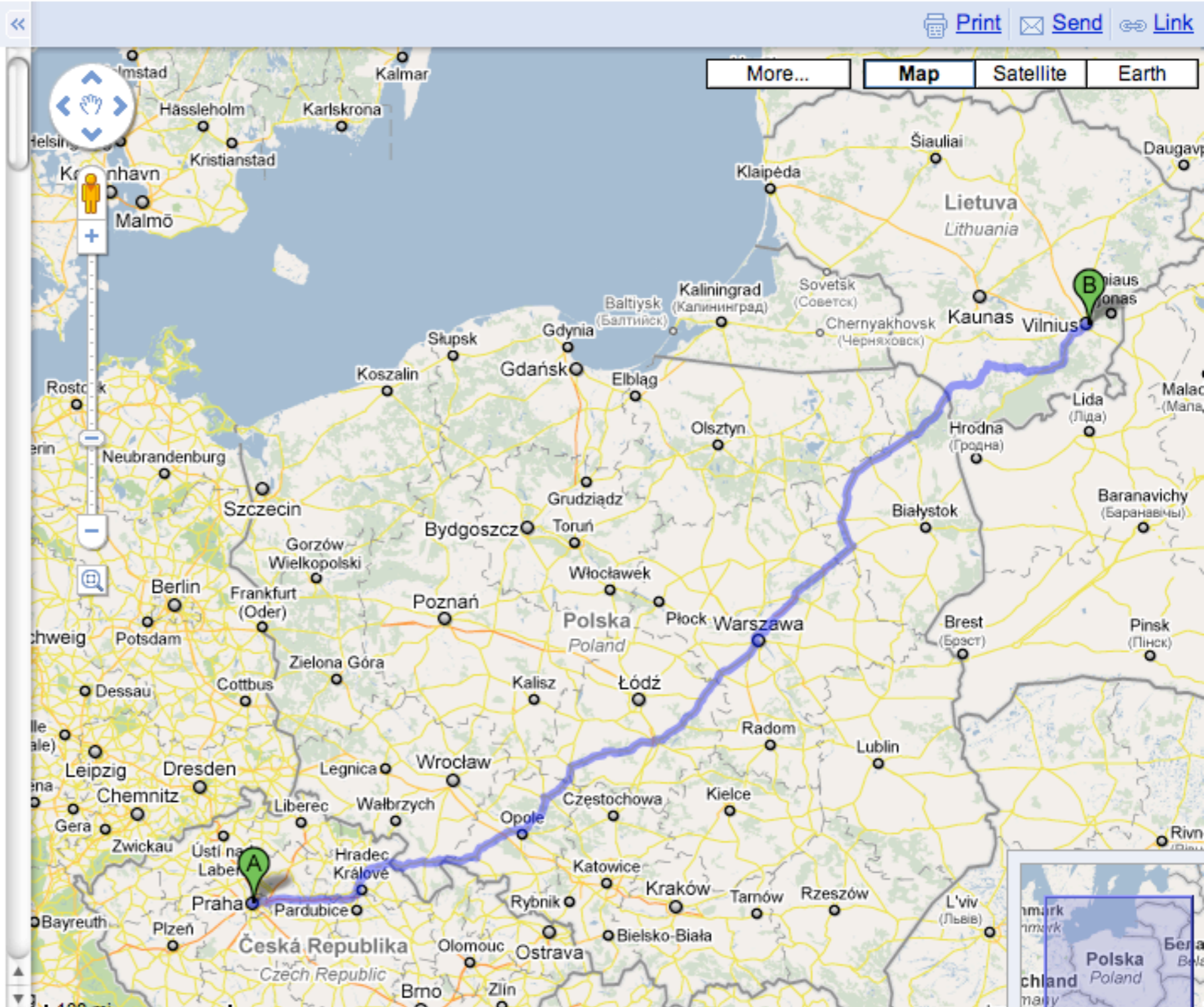

1. Head **east** on **Dlouhá** toward **Staroměstské nám.** 220 m
2. Turn **right** to stay on **Dlouhá** 40 m
3. Continue onto **Masná** 86 m
4. Turn **left** to stay on **Masná** 160 m
5. Turn **left** at **Rybná** 81 m
6. Take the 1st **right** onto **Dlouhá** 150 m
7. Take the 2nd **left** onto **Revoluční** 210 m
8. Turn **right** at **Lannova** 73 m
9. Turn **left** at **Nové mlýny** 62 m
