# Consistency in References

- RIPE community develops policies
- But...
- When it comes to “documenting”
  - Proposers are set as authors
  - But not always...
- Average RIPE citizen makes wording suggestions too
- Authors list is growing
- Some policies changed
  - Those who proposed them are still listed as author



# Suggestion

- Refer to “RIPE” at the top
- All proposers are contributors
  - Acknowledgement in the document at end



# Heads-up to proposers

- Proposals published on RIPE website
- They are for the “benefit” of the community
- No economic rights attached
- No right to restrict access to proposals published
- What is accepted at a time can change later
- Their contribution will be noted in resulting RIPE documentation
- Proposals and RIPE documentation are available to all, without any prior permission
