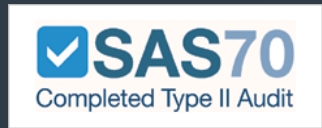

Istanbul IX

- 1600 m² of colocation floorspace in the Mediteranean Nautilus undersea cable head!
- Global connectivity from multiple international carriers either via undersea link or terrestrial fiber
- Redundant fiber connectivity from multiple Turkish operators including Turk Telekom and Superonline
- Only carrier-neutral IX in the region with the ability to reach Jordan, Israel, Iraq, Iran and Syria
- Force10 peering platform, but looking at Arista and Brocade.



Collocation Area

- Security Enabled Cages with Electronic Access Control System
- Redundant power distribution infrastructure
- High Capacity Central York Cooling System
- Liebert CRAC's
- Raised floor environment

Security and Fire Suppression

- 24/7 Security on-site security personnel
- Card based Secure Entrance System throughout the facility.
- Bosch Camera system for 24 hour surveillance
- FM-200 and water-based pre-action fire suppression system.
